

Our Catholic Family Joint Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes
All Saints, Holy Family & St. Rose of Lima
December 20, 2021

- I. Opening Prayer – Fr. Keiter
- II. Present – Fr. Keiter, Frank Kleinschmit, Linda Jackson, Curt Steffen, Beth Stevens, Alex Heine, Matt Pinkelman, John Connot and Penny Reifenrath. Rachel Becker was excused.
- III. Review of Minutes: Linda Jackson made a motion seconded by Matt Pinkelman to approve the minutes from the November 2021 Meeting. The motion was unanimously approved.
- IV. Parish Financial Reports: The financial reports for each parish were discussed. All budgets are looking good. Beth Stevens made a motion seconded by Curt Steffen to approve the reports. The motion was unanimously approved.
- V. Old Business:
 - a. Mass Counts were discussed. The numbers were down from last month. About one-third of registered members are attending Mass.
- VI. New Business:
 - a. Chris and Linda Padgett will return on January 15th for a marriage enrichment day. The first one was rescheduled due to a December snow storm.
 - b. The Retreat and Strategic Thinking/Planning Meeting was rescheduled for Saturday, January 8th from 8:30 a.m. to 4:00 p.m.
 - c. The All Saints finance committee recommendation for tithing from the Fun Night was discussed. The monies will be divided between Zoe Care, Haven House, River City Domestic Violence Center, Hartington Senior Center and Crofton Senior Center. A motion was made by Beth Stevens and seconded by John Connot to accept this recommendation. The motion was unanimously approved.
 - d. Father has been approached by Michelle Kleinschmit who would like to live in the St. Boniface Rectory. A discussion was held and a motion made by Penny Reifenrath and seconded by Alex Heine to rent the rectory. The motion was unanimously approved with Frank Kleinschmit abstaining from the vote because he is a relative.
 - e. Father discussed the appointment of Parish Trustees for each of the Parish Corporations. It is required to have two lay members appointed for each. Father appointed the officers from each parish who serve on the parish council along with the chairperson from the finance committee.
 - f. A discussion was held on the addition of personnel for the 2022-23 budget. Father would like to hire a part-time communication coordinator to oversee the web site, Facebook, flock notes and help keep communications up to date with all parish information.
 - g. A date was set for January 8th prior to the retreat to take the Pastoral Council group picture for the parish directory.

A motion was made by Linda Jackson, seconded by Alex Heine to adjourn the meeting. The motion was unanimously carried. A closing prayer was led by Fr. Keiter. The next meeting will be January 17, 2022 at 7:30 p.m. at St. Rose Parish Center New Addition, Crofton.
