Dear Parish Families:

I pray you are all having a blessed and merry Christmas with family and friends. Our family and friends are a tremendous blessing that we need to thank God for every day.

You will find on the reverse side of this letter, our Prime Rib FUN Night 2021 financial report. After not being able to have our St. John's Prime Rib Dinner and FUN Night in 2020, the decision was made to combine the two and create this year's Prime Rib FUN Night which was held at the St. Boniface Parish Center. Special thanks to our core team who led the charge in organizing this year's inaugural event: Lori and Dennis Hoebelheinrich, Janel and Ryan Loecker, Shannon and Jeff Birger, Rhonda and Lyle Lammers, and Lori and Ken Eickhoff.

This year's event netted \$85,049.85 Wow! Great job everyone! As has been the practice, we tithed a percentage of our earnings to some area non-profits in thanksgiving for God's many blessings to us as, All Saints Parish. This year our All Saints Finance Committee chose the following: Crofton Senior Center \$1000, Hartington Senior Center \$1000, Haven House Family Services \$2000, River City Domestic Violence Center \$2000 and Zoe Care - Emergency Pregnancy Center \$2000.

After tithing \$8000.00 from our net profit that leaves us with a \$77,049.85. We budgeted \$50,000 of Prime Rib Fun Night to the general operations of All Saints Parish. The remaining \$27,049.85 we put into savings for capital improvement projects primarily at St. Boniface because for the time being, we have the annual raffle/car raffle to provide for capital improvements at St. John the Baptist. We then have our earnings from the Rodney Lammers estate that help us with any capital needs at St. Joseph. I share this so everyone understands how the monies are used but please remember, we are ONE PARISH as All Saints and hence we ALL are responsible for ALL three of our beautiful Churches and properties. I cannot stress enough – WE ARE ONE.

Thank you for your support of our Parish and particularly this year's Prime Rib FUN Night.
