April 13, 2021

- I. The meeting was called to order by Vernon Arens.
- II. Opening Prayer – Fr. Keiter
- III. Present – Fr. Keiter, Ron Wieseler, Matt Pinkelman, Linda Jackson, Ed Steffen, Curt Steffen, Rachel Becker, Frank Kleinschmit and Vernon Arens; Absent (sick) Penny Reifenrath.
- IV. Review of Minutes: Linda Jackson made a motion seconded by Frank Kleinschmit to approve the minutes from the March 2021 Meeting. Minutes approved
- V. Parish Financial Reports: Sunday giving continues to be very good in all three parishes. We reviewed the budget to date. The addition to St. John’s parish center is going well. Ron Wieseler made a motion to accept the financial reports, seconded by Curt Steffen. The motion was unanimously carried.

 - c. Discussion was held on the Holy Family Finance Committee’s recommendation to sell 7 lots in St. Helena at \$1500 per lot. Ron Wieseler moved to accept this recommendation. Rachel Becker seconded the motion. Motion was approved.
