

Our Catholic Family Joint Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes  
All Saints, Holy Family & St. Rose of Lima  
June 28, 2021

- I. The meeting was called to order by Vernon Arens.
- II. Opening Prayer – Fr. Keiter
- III. Present – Fr. Keiter, Ron Wieseler, Matt Pinkelman, Linda Jackson, Ed Steffen, Curt Steffen, Frank Kleinschmit, Vernon Arens, Rachel Becker and Penny Reifenrath. Guest: Pam Evans
- IV. Review of Minutes: Linda Jackson made a motion seconded by Ed Steffen to approve the minutes from the May 2021 Meeting.
- V. Discussion about the St. Rose Bazaar in September: Pam Evans attended the meeting to discuss the St. Rose Bazaar. The meat prices have changed drastically from previous years. She explained all the different aspects of the bazaar, i.e. games they have, what they serve for the meal, volunteers, pre-donations that are asked for, etc. The Council members and Father Keiter were in agreement that it was okay for Pam and her committee to try to simplify or change things from the previous years. It was discussed to make the meal easier by possibly having less selections. It was also discussed to eliminate or in some way change how pre-donations are paid.
- VI. Parish Financial Reports: Sunday giving continues to be very good in all three parishes. All income and expenses are in line where they should be. The Parish Center renovations in Fordyce were also discussed. Ron Wieseler made a motion, seconded by Ed Steffen to approve the financial reports.
- VII. Old Business:
  - a. Sale of Lots in St. Helena: A counter offer to the counter offer was made of \$1,300.00 which was accepted. There are 7 lots that will be sold for \$1,300.00 a piece. Ron Wieseler made a motion to accept this offer, seconded by Frank Kleinschmit.
  - b. Mass Counts were discussed. The numbers stayed about steady from the previous count. Father will continue to do counts once a month.
- VIII. New Business:
  - a. FOCUS site visit and missionaries: Father discussed the FOCUS visit. It was decided by the FOCUS visitors that the missionaries would live in the old rectory building in Bow Valley. They should begin their work on September 1, 2021. The music room for East & West Catholic will move into the building currently used for PE. There will be a room built specifically for the music program inside the existing building.

The Council spent the rest of the meeting discussing the seventh chapter of the Made for Missions book. The meeting ended with a prayer by Father Keiter. The next regular meeting will be on July 19 at 7:30 p.m. in Fordyce.
