### January

Officers for 2020 St. Rose Ladies' Guild were installed January 13: President Holly Wortmann, Vice President Kelly Wiebelhaus, Treasurer Sharlene Guenther. Guild books and dues envelopes were printed and put in the back of church. A copy of the book was emailed to 108 members. Boxes were put in Peoples' Grocery and at the back of church to collect items for the Unity Supper basket donation. Division 1 (Nancy Wortmann) cleaned the church. Division 6 (Barb Koch) took Christmas décor down.

### February

A guild social and new member/ chair welcome was held February 17<sup>th</sup>. President Holly Wortmann prepared snacks and refreshments. ### April

### May

A virtual meeting via Zoom was held May 4<sup>th</sup>. Topics discussed included \$30 in Crofton Community Club Bucks sent to each priest: Fr Andy (May 8) and Fr Jim (Feb 5). (3) \$100 scholarships awarded from Guild to St. Rose School. Parish monetary gift of \$4000, spring cleaning of rectory was put on hold, as well as funeral luncheons. Annual Rural North Central Deanery Council of Catholic Women news discussed as well as paid annual dues, send Penny and Prayer for Vocation and Madonna Plan donation and collections for Penny and a Prayer for Vocations for local priests.

### June

The OACCW Convention was held in Crofton September 16<sup>th</sup>. Division 3 (Barb Zavadil) helped Merkel Catering serve the luncheon to 160 participants. Penny and a Prayer jars were taken to the St. Rose School Principal and the CCD Coordinator along with a vocations prayer. A \$500 donation for books was gifted to the St. Rose School Book Fair for a teacher shopping spree. Division 9 (Charlotte Arens) cleaned the church. Division 12 (Donna Arens) cleaned the hall kitchen and chair room.
