

Our Catholic Family Joint Pastoral Council Meeting Minutes
All Saints, Holy Family & St. Rose of Lima
February 15, 2022

- I. Opening Prayer – Fr. Keiter
- II. Present for the parish council meeting– Fr. Keiter, Frank Kleinschmit, Linda Jackson, Curt Steffen, Beth Stevens, Alex Heine, Matt Pinkelman, John Connot, Rachel Becker and Penny Reifenrath. Present for the meeting executive session: Parish council members plus Sonya Schroeder, Jennifer Fiscus, Eric Derickson, Jimmy Chang and Karen Leader.
- III. Review of Minutes: Linda Jackson made a motion seconded by John Connot to approve the minutes from the January 2022 Meeting. The motion was unanimously approved.
- IV. Parish Financial Reports: The financial reports for each parish were discussed. All budgets are looking good. The expenses for all 3 parishes are higher because of the higher price of propane. Beth Stevens made a motion seconded by Rachel Becker to approve the reports. The motion was unanimously approved.
- V. Old Business:
 - a. Mass Counts were discussed. The numbers were up 100 from last month.
 - b. The Immaculate Conception kitchen and apartment roof project has been completed except for some trim work. There was enough room for ventilation that they didn't need to go thru the roof for the ventilation. The air conditioning system was moved from the roof to the ground.
 - c. Attorney Pat Flood sent the Purchase Agreement for the lots to Tyler Boeckman. The cost was \$1,300 per lot for a total of \$9,100.00. Tyler is responsible for the closing costs.
 - d. A religious formation meeting is set for March 26th at 8:30 a.m. at St. John's Parish Center in Fordyce for anyone involved in adult or student religious formation.
 - e. A meeting for all ushers was held at the St. John's Parish Center on Saturday, February 12th. It was well attended by each parish. There will be a video and also a printout of what was discussed for ushers who were unable to attend the meeting. They talked about how ushers are the first people who can make an impression as people come to Church. They should arrive 15 minutes before Mass to hold the doors and greet ALL people coming into and leaving Church. There should be two ushers for each Mass. This can be guys, families or couples. During Masses such as Easter and Christmas, the collection will be taken up during Mass. Second collections will also be taken up during Mass. The ushers will also ask for gift bearers for Mass beginning on the March 5/6 Masses.
- VI. New Business:
 - a. Father handed out a draft of the communications' position job duties.
 - b. We discussed the business manager position.
 - c. Jim and Mary Ann Wortmann will be retiring from the St. Rose Cemetery Committee. Erin Foxhoven will take over the duties of collecting money for plots and the plot map which will now be locked up in the safe. Father will be looking for someone else to do the marking of the plots when needed.
 - d. Unity Supper special project was discussed. The Unity Supper was very upbeat and positive. Close to 200 tickets were sold but all the information is not available at this time. The money will be used for updates to the parish hall main space and bathrooms. The goal was \$15,000 and close to \$30,000 was raised. The Archdiocese rules must be followed on the updates.

The parish council and guests then went into executive session.

A motion was made by Linda Jackson, seconded by Beth Stevens to adjourn the meeting. The motion was unanimously carried. The next meeting will be March 21, 2022 at 7:30 p.m. at the Ss. Peter and Paul Church Basement.
